



Emergency medical attention

WHAT

You can get emergency medical attention 24 h per day.

HOW

If you need emergency medical attention, you can call the emergency number (112). You can also call directly the ambulance (144).

From Monday to Friday from 7pm to 7am and on weekends and public holidays, you can call the number -141- to get in contact with doctors on call.

People with hearing impairment can contact the fire brigade, police or ambulance via a special emergency text service: by sending a fax or SMS to the number 0800 133 133, or an email to gehoerlosennotruf@polizei.gv.at.

GOOD TO KNOW

These phone numbers are for free (you can call even if you don't have credit on your phone) and available in the entire country. They generally speak English and German.
